## Acute pain relief in drug dependent patient undergoing acute surgery

- •All drug dependant patients should be assessed by the DDU
- •Pain relief will be managed jointly
- •DDU supervises Methadone and Buprenorphine replacement therapy
- •APT manages opioids for severe pain

## Level 1: Patient on stable methadone replacement therapy, well known to DDU

- Standard PCA suitable/ Continue methadone
- Follow sc protocol

## Level 2: Not known to DDU.

- Started on 10mg Methadone BD,
- Assessed and followed up by DDU

Use subcutaneous morphine dose start on 10mg PRN via Y Can For surgical procedures give methadone preoperative and use immediate release morphine for acute postoperative period

Patient discharged on Methadone and simple analgesics Prescription guide

- •DO maintain methadone as long as possible
- •DO keep methadone dose constant unless advised by DDU
- •DO NOT prescribe DF118
- •DO NOT prescribe Temgesic
- •DO NOT prescribe oxycontin
- •DO NOT prescribe im/iv/sc if oral route feasible
