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


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# **Campaign Objectives**

# IASP Educational Support

- IASP Educational Grants 10 grants each of up to US\$10,000 for educational initiatives in developing countries
- IASP Trainee Fellowships 2 grants each of up to US\$50,000 for education in pain management
- Financial Aid Support for participants to attend the 13th World Congress on Pain
- Chapter Support Visiting Professor grants for speakers at Chapter meetings
- Early Career Research Grants 7 grants each of up to US\$7,000 for those in their early careers of pain investigation
